Sunday Worship is broadcast each Sunday On BBC Radio 4 (92-95 FM, 103-105 FM) from 8.10am to 8.58am.

On BBC1 on the television **this Sunday at 1.15pm**, Katherine Jenkins is in London to pay tribute to all carers on the front line for **Songs of Praise 'Celebrating Florence Nightingale and the NHS'**. Katherine learns about the extraordinary legacy of Florence Nightingale, born 200 years ago this year. She also meets the Archbishop of Canterbury, Justin Welby, who has been volunteering as a Chaplain at St Thomas' during lockdown. With hymns and songs from across the UK recorded before lockdown.

"Detailed advice for parishes and cathedrals is available on the Church of England website: www.churchofengland.org/more/media-centre/coronavirus-covid-19-guidance-churches . It will be updated, as necessary, in the coming days to reflect the detail of the Government guidance once published."

"Weddings will be able to resume, along with other services. Updated advice for couples will be published as part of the updates mentioned above. The Church of England Recovery Group will also issue advice on subjects including singing and music for which a review by Public Health England is currently in progress."

Although our churches remain temporarily closed for public services this week, **our churches are open for private prayer on the following days and times**:

St John the Baptist Church in Woodland is open daily, 9am to 5pm

The Church of St Mary the Virgin in Denbury is open daily, 10am to 6pm.

St Andrew's Church in Ipplepen is open daily, 9am to 5pm.

St Peter & St Paul's Church in Broadhempston is open on Sundays and Wednesdays, 9am to 4pm.

St Peter & St Paul's church, looks forward to soon holding **Broadhempston's first wedding since the lockdown**. This will be taking place on **Saturday 11th July** with a restricted number of guests in line with the current guidance. Please note that **access to St Peter & St Paul's church for private prayer is on Sundays and Wednesdays** and therefore access will be need to remain restricted on Saturday 11th July due to limitations on numbers of people in the church at any time and due to necessary cleaning before and following the wedding ceremony.

Please note that a private funeral, with a restricted number of people attending, is due to be held in St Andrew's Church, Ipplepen, on **Tuesday 7th July at 11am** so **St Andrew's will not be open for private prayer at that time**.

We are currently looking at how we can best live-stream to 'You-tube' our church services (or record and upload the recording to You-tube shortly after the service) for those people that will continue to shield at home once our church services begin to resume in our church buildings.
