Our Mission Community

There is a real flourishing of theology and worship in our mission community as we begin to gather again. Last Sunday for example we had reflections offered on the spiritual discipline of 'turning aside' and Moses and the burning bush, the call of Love and Pauls words and advice in Romans. We had a wonderful piece of rites of passage and the rhythm of creation from Tess following her recent trip to be with her granddaughter. This theology was placed within a variety of acts of worship - communion, morning worship and Celtic morning prayer as well as in written form sent out by email, post, left to pick up in our churches and on Facebook. There certainly seems to be a real flourishing. We just need to be careful we don't get overgrown!!!

We are currently in Creationtide, during which we are, amongst other things, having pet services in Ipplepen and Broadhempston and, looking forward, we have our Harvest festivals being planned for October.

November marks the end of the church year with the themes of remembering and God's Kingdom.

We are also planning for our rescheduled APCM's which will take place at the end of September and beginning of October. I am working on a document which sets out our priorities as a mission community and parishes from now until our next APCM's in April/ Easter 2021. The aim of this is to give clear direction and focus as we re-establish our gathered church life over this time.
