

## Wedding Fees, August 2021 to December 2021

Publication of banns of marriage	£31
Marriage Service	£464
Heating (*during cold months)	£50
Organist (*Cash to be handed to the Church Representative/Church Warden at your wedding rehearsal, usually the day prior to your wedding ceremony, to pass onto the Organist) (*Fee for our resident organist. Fees may vary for other organists)	£75
Church Representative (*Cash to be paid to the Church Representative/Church Warden at your wedding rehearsal, usually the day prior to your wedding)	£35
Wedding bells – (full peal of 8 ringers) (*Cash to be handed to the Church representative/Church Warden at your wedding rehearsal, usually the day prior to your wedding, to pass onto the bellringers.)  <i>Wedding bells – (Ellacombe Chimes – 2 to 3 ringers)</i> <i>During times when Covid 19 restrictions mean that a full peal of 8 ringers are not permitted, we can offer the Ellacombe Chimes instead at Broadhempston and Ipplepen (but unfortunately not at Denbury or Woodland). The fee for the Ellacombe chimes is £80.</i>  Please ensure you have let The Church Office know that you would like wedding bells in order the bell ringers are booked.	£180

Please note that if you live in a different parish to the church in which your wedding ceremony is being held then your Banns will also need to be read at the church in the parish in which you live and that church will charge you a separate fee for that.

Please note, if your ceremony is not taking place in 2021, that there is likely to be a very small increase in fees each year.

## **Payments for Wedding Fees, August 2021 to December 2021**

### **Deposit**

**A deposit of £30 is required after the first wedding meeting with Reverend Andrew Down and before the second wedding meeting with Reverend Andrew Down.**

This can be paid either by cheque or by a direct transfer payment.

### **Main Wedding Fee (if deposit not paid previously)**

**This remaining fee is due one month prior to the wedding ceremony, to include:**

£31	Payment for publication of Banns of Marriage
£464	Marriage service.

### **Main Wedding Fee (if deposit paid previously)**

- £30

### **Additional Fee for Heating (during cold months)**

\*Optional £50 heating fee to be added to this main wedding fee payment if heating is required.

The main wedding fee and heating fee can be paid either by cheque or by a direct transfer payment.

### **Additional cash payments (to be paid at your wedding rehearsal)**

At your wedding rehearsal, usually the day prior to your wedding ceremony, please hand your cash payments to the Church Representative/Church Warden for the following people:

- The Organist
- The Church representative
- The Bell ringers

### **Payment for Marriage Certificate (following your ceremony)**

We will provide you with a temporary unofficial 'Congratulations' certificate on the day which will be signed by the Reverend but you will still need to order your formal legal certificate.

Following your ceremony, the Reverend will forward your signed Marriage Document to the Register Office. You will then be able to order your marriage certificate directly from the Register Office.

There will be a fee of £11 for this which you will need to pay directly to the Register Office. Please note this is the new method, from 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2021, for obtaining your certificate.
