Step 2. Maundy Thursday 17th April – including foot washing and followed by The Watch.

7pm – St Andrew's, Ipplepen

Maundy Thursday of Holy Week – 17th April

10.30am – Chrism Eucharist in Exter Cathedral



Step 3. Good Friday 18th April – Sitting at the foot of the Cross.

12 noon – 3pm St Peter and St Paul's, Broadhempston

Note – Come and go as you wish. Come for five minutes or the whole three hours. The church will be set up with prayer stations, there will be reading, poetry and art available to aid your reflection and prayer and every 25 minutes there will be a short reflection read out based on one of Jesus' 7 last words from the Cross.
